Community-based Aboriginal Teacher Education Program

The Winnipeg School Division is partnered with the University of Winnipeg and various school Divisions within the Province to develop a teacher education program intended to address the shortage of aboriginal teachers in our schools.

This program is open to all non-teaching employees of the Division who are of Aboriginal descent.

The six-year Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Education program requires 90 credit hours of course work to complete the BA and 60 credit hours to complete the B.Ed. Interested applicants, who already hold a BA or have some university credits, may be able to transfer their course credits to the BA or B.Ed. program offered through CATEP.
