## Manitoba Increases Restrictions in Level Red

### MANITOBA INCREASES RESTRICTIONS IN LEVEL RED

Manitoba's Chief Provincial Public Health Officer, Dr. Brent Roussin, and Premier Brian Pallister announced that as of 12:01 a.m. on Thursday, Nov. 12, the province of Manitoba will increase restrictions in the critical level (red).

Dr. Roussin stated no changes would be made to Child-Care services or to Nursery to Grade 12 education at this time. Dr. Roussin also said they have not seen a widespread transmission of Covid-19 among children, students, and staff.

All WSD employees are deemed Critical Service Workers, therefore, the following exemption has been made: ***If you (the employee) are asymptomatic and have a member of the household that is symptomatic, you are exempt from self-isolation.*** That means, if somebody in your household is showing signs of illness but you are not, you must report to work. This has been confirmed by Public Health.

With all of the uncertainty, I want to thank you for your unwavering dedication to our schools and students during this time. I know we are all apprehensive about what's to come, and navigating the constant changes has not been easy. I will continue to update all of you, as new information becomes available.
