Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) & RELATE Training

Winnipeg School Division has introduced a new and updated version of **NCI** (Nonviolent Crisis Intervention). The updated version is a blended training module which provides a half-day self-led virtual session followed by a full-day in-person session.

Inclusion Support Services supports schools by creating and reviewing student specific plans, SHARP line reports and planning for safe and caring school communities. We are pleased to be able to offer priority NCI enrolment for EAs and teaching staff who work with students in Inclusion Support Services Low Enrolment Programs, school crisis response teams, and additional staff who require support in expanding their de-escalation and supportive intervention skills.

The training will be delivered by a team of Inclusion Support Teachers from Inclusion Support Services. The divisional NCI program has been tailored with a focus on preventative measures and safety for all. NCI is an additional approach that can be used to debrief challenging situations, plan forward, and navigate potential unexpected situations.

RELATE Training (Regulate, Empathy, Learn, Adapt, Team, Experience) will continue as the building block and prerequisite for NCI, as it provides a diverse lens for understanding trauma, child and adolescent brain development and supportive practices that foster safe and caring learning environments for all.

The training expectations are as follows:

RELATE: 1 full-day virtual training – Prerequisite for NCI

NCI: ½ day online module to be completed prior to NCI session
1 full-day in-person training
